
## An American Union Ends the Federal Drug War

- Reform qualified immunity and Pell grant eligibility.
- ✓ Review prison sentences after 10 years.
- Repeal mandatory minimum sentences, the federal war on drugs, and civil asset forfeiture.
- ✓ Restore the ability to vote in federal elections.
